Previously, Brigitte was an executive working as Deputy Director at the Academic Cooperation Association (ACA), an international organisation. In 2004 and 1999 she ran for office at the European Parliament. From 1991-96 Brigitte Hasewend was Deputy Director for International Relations at TU Graz.
