Building capacity in gender research was an important goal of the project. An intercultural research seminar, a course on qualitative methodology (new to IUG), and interactive MA research were at the core of this project component. IUG staff conducted a research project on attitudes towards gender equality in higher education and published the results in an international journal.

- One-year research seminar offered the opportunity to consult on individual research projects
- A workshop series on qualitative methods for gender researchers, attended by 57 faculty and students at IUG, and run as a regular MA course for students of Uni Graz
- Support for 8 “Mirror MA” theses (4 at IUG, 4 at Uni Graz)

Participants from the Islamic University Gaza had the opportunity to consult their research projects over a whole year with Prof. Libora Oates-Indruchová, professor of Sociology of Gender and the leader of the SHE_GE project at Uni Graz.

Qualitative Methods for Gender Researchers

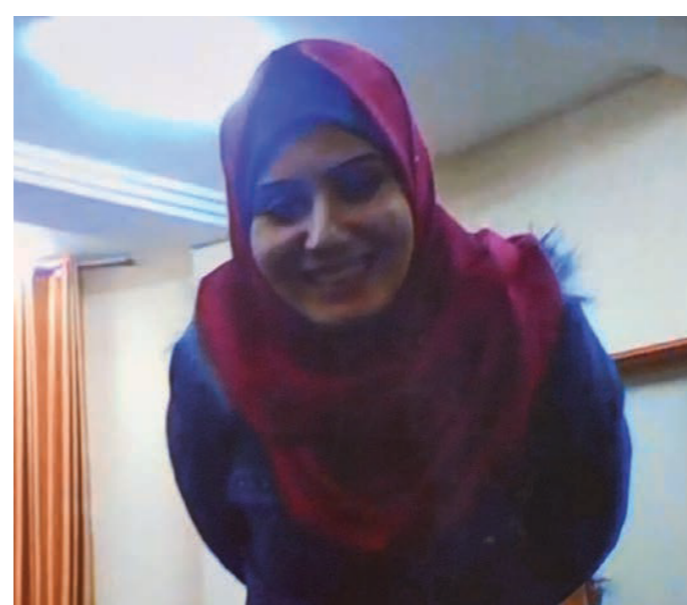
(57 participants – 41 women, 16 men)

Full-day lecture-workshop blocks by specialists in particular methods gave the participants a hands-on introduction to four different methods of qualitative research.

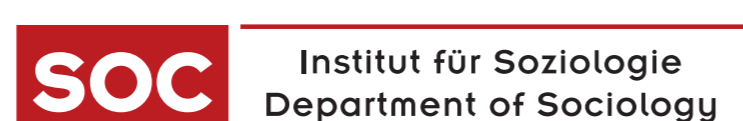
