Depending on the participants the Summer School will be held in German or English language. The Summer School is sponsored by the Fachgruppe Gesundheitspsychologie (FG) and the Arbeitsbereich Gesundheitspsychologie of the Karl-Franzens-Universität Graz. Membership in the Fachgruppe Gesundheitspsychologie and registration for the conference are required. No extra fee applies.

Please send in your abstract (max. 300 words) with a description of your project and a statement of motivation by 4th Mai 2015 to klusmann@uni-bremen.de. Participants will be notified about acceptance by 15th June 2015 and must confirm their participation by payment of the conference fee by 15th July 2015.

In the core part of the Summer School participants will present their dissertation projects in approx. 25 min. and will then discuss the current status with experts and peers.

Workshop (sponsored by the FG)

In this year's workshop, basic principles of multilevel regression analysis (hierarchical linear modeling / random effects modeling) will be conceptually introduced. Participants will learn how to estimate and interpret the random intercept, random slope, and slopes as outcomes models. Moreover, participants will learn how to strategically build multilevel models hands-on using the statistic software "R". Participants should be familiar with regression analysis. Participants do not have to be familiar with "R".
