

Intended Courses for the Application

Important information (read carefully!)

- Intended Courses must be uploaded during the application process. Changes are still possible until course registration deadlines prior to the semester start.
- Course registration takes place in September (for winter semester) and February (for summer semester)
- Information on workload and grading is available [here](#).
- *Students applying for a stay starting in the fall* will work with courses of the academic year preceding their stay. This is due to the fact that courses for any academic year are not confirmed and online before July.
- Select courses for the semester of your stay & at your current level of enrollment.
- We strongly advise students to compile their *list of intended courses also including back-up courses*. In case you do not receive a placement in every course on your priority list, you do have back-ups to fall back on.
- Students who do not speak English at a level enabling them to follow courses in German are advised to check for *English-taught courses* to see if they can find enough courses relevant to their degree at the home university.
